Naming of Personal Property

Hat Policy

Safety under the sun is paramount and our 'SunSmart' policy mandates a school issue bucket hat with a brim for outdoor activities when the UV index exceeds 3. Hats are to be worn from 1st August to 31st May.

Uniform Policy

All Good Shepherd Lutheran School students are required to wear the official uniform while at school and during their commute to and from school.

All Curiosity ELC students are required to wear the official ELC uniform while at Curiosity and during their commute to and from the centre.

Consistent use of wearing the uniform is the important, e.g., complete uniform for any of the specified options. Unless otherwise stated, students are required to wear the correct school uniform at all times while engaging in school activities. School uniforms should be correctly fitting, clean and in good repair.

Hair Styles

- Hair is to be neatly cut and styled so as not to draw unnecessary attention to the student. No designs cut into short hair styles.
- Hair colour not to be significantly changed from natural colouring
- Long hair is to be tied back away from the face.
- Short hair should not be less than a 'Number 3' over the top.

Not Permitted

- Items of uniform that replace any 'compulsory school issue only' items for students attending the school
- Items of uniform that replace any 'compulsory school/ELC issue only' items.
- Make up, nail polish, tattoos/temporary tattoos
- Smart watch (interactive watch).

Optional Accessories Permitted

- Medic alert bracelet
- Wristwatch
- Small silver or gold plain sleepers or studs (One per earlobe, no other piercings permitted)
- Plain navy blue or white hair accessories (ribbons, headbands, clips, ties)
- Plain navy blue jacket over rugby top / jumper on days of extreme or inclement weather

Compulsory School Issue

- Curiosity polo - short sleeve or long sleeve
- Curiosity fleece rugby
- Hat (must be worn between 1st August – 31st May)
- School bag
- Communication bag, used for library

Compulsory Non-School Issue

- Plain navy pants, shorts, or skort
- Plain white socks
- Sport shoes – closed toe, any colour permitted

Optional School Issue

Accessories:

- Hair accessories in Curiosity colours (Navy Blue and/or White)
- Navy blue scarf
- Logo beanie (Can be worn during outside play when school hat not required)

UNISEX SCHOOL SPORTS UNIFORM

Compulsory School Issue Only

- Navy shorts or track pants
- Polo shirt (short or long sleeve)
- Sports Jumper
- White school logo crew socks
- Hat (must be worn between August – May)

Non School Issue

- Sport Shoes – predominately white, black, or grey cross trainers/joggers, with same colour laces or velcro.

Interpretations

- ‘Predominantly’ implies that the majority of the shoe, including the main body of the shoe, is one of the three approved colours with no bright non-school colour trim or detail such as red, orange, yellow, pink.
- ‘Cross trainers / joggers’ does not include basketball boots, leisure, or street shoes

Optional School Issue

Accessories:

- Plain navy blue or white hair accessories (e.g., ribbons, headbands, clips, ties)
- Plain navy blue jacket over rugby top / jumper on days of extreme or inclement weather

BOYS FORMAL UNIFORM

Compulsory School Issue Only

- Grey trousers or shorts.
- Shirt. (long or short sleeve permitted)
- Cable knit jumper.
- Charcoal crew socks.

Optional School Issue

- Tie optional when student is wearing a long sleeve shirt.
- Art smock

Non School Issue

- Shoes – Plain black 'leather style' lace up.

GIRLS FORMAL UNIFORM

Compulsory School Issue Only

Option 1*

- Dress.**
- Navy crew socks.

Option 2*

- Shirt. (long or short sleeve permitted)
- Skirt.**
- Choice of navy tights or navy knee-high socks. (applies to the skirt only)

Option 3*

- Shirt. (long or short sleeve permitted)
- Navy trousers or navy shorts.
- Navy crew socks.

*Any of the above options may be worn with or without the formal cable knit jumper.

Optional School Issue

- Tie optional when student is wearing a long sleeve shirt.
- Art smock

Non School Issue

- Shoes – Plain black 'leather style' lace up or plain black 'Mary Jane' style.

Note: Any of the three options may be worn at any time throughout the year providing it is complete: e.g., ankle socks cannot be worn with the skirt, and tights/knee high socks cannot be worn with the dress or shorts.

**Note: Both skirt and dress must be no shorter than 5cm above the knee when kneeling. This is to allow for personal comfort of the student when participating in school activities and play, and when performing on stage.



UNISEX SPORTS UNIFORM

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND OPTIONS

Compulsory School Issue

- Navy shorts or track pants.
- Polo shirt - short sleeve or long sleeve.
- Sports jumper.
- White crew socks.
- Hat. (must be worn between August – May)

Non School Issue

- Sport Shoes - predominately white, black, or grey cross trainers/joggers, with same colour laces or velcro.

Interpretations

- 'Predominantly' implies that the majority of the shoe, including the main body of the shoe, is one of the three approved colours with no bright non-school colour trim or detail such as red, orange, yellow, pink.
